

PERMIT SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

In addition to a completed application, all permit submissions are required to include the following information:

- Electrical application to cover the electrical work associated with the system; i.e., filter system, heater and lighting.
- Manufacture's specs for the pool, filter system and heater must be submitted with permit applications.
- The proposed location of the pool must be on all copies of the Plat of Survey.

Location

- Must meet the zoning setbacks, front, rear and side yards.
- Must be located 10 feet from overhead utility wires and 5 feet from underground utility wires.

REGULATIONS

- Fencing is required; the yard must be fenced with a minimum 4' fence with a self-locking gate
- Or if above ground pool installed the pool structure can be used as the barrier if it is 48" above grade. An additional barrier may be mounted on top of the pool structure to meet the 48" barrier height requirement. The access ladder or steps must be capable of being secured, locked or removed to prevent access.
- If a dwelling wall is used as a barrier, any door opening into pool area must have an audible alarm or be self-closing, self-latching with a lock a minimum of 54" above the floor.
- A single purpose GFCI receptacle is required for the pump, located between 5 and 10 feet from the pool.

Why apply for a Permit?


When you apply for a permit, you are assisting the City in conducting a plan review and the subsequent inspections that will ensure that all construction in the community meet specific safety and quality guidelines.

The City is on your side. We want to ensure that you will enjoy your pool for many years to come. The permit you receive for this project will allow us to do just that.

The City of Wood Dale is dedicated to assisting its residents. The Community Development & Building Department will show you this dedication as you apply for and receive your pool permit.

The Permit Process

1. Obtain a permit application from the Building Department which is located at 404 N. Wood Dale Rd.
2. Return the complete application with two (2) copies of your plat of survey to the Building Department. Please refer to submission requirements for additional necessary information.
3. After you receive your permit, and at least 48 hours before you begin digging, call JULIE at 1-800-892-0123 for utility locations.



INSPECTIONS

- **Final upon completion of pool**
- Rough Electric required for trench where wiring is to be installed.
- Final Electric after backfill of trench and restoration of lawn.

Requesting Inspections

To schedule an inspection, contact the Building Department at (630) 766-5133, Monday thru Friday between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Requests for inspections must be made 24 hours in advance. Please have your permit number ready when you call.
