<p>Acid</p> <p>Aerosol spray cans – Not empty, still containing product</p> <p>Antifreeze</p> <p>Asbestos</p> <p>Batteries – Sort into separate plastic bags and label as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Alkaline</li> <li>• Button</li> <li>• Lead Acid (Pb) &amp; Gel Cell</li> <li>• Lithium (Li)</li> <li>• Mercury</li> <li>• Nickel/Cadmium (Ni-Cd)</li> <li>• SLA: car, lawnmower, motorcycle, sump pump</li> <li>• Zinc</li> <li>• Other</li> </ul> <p>Fertilizer</p> <p>Fluorescent CFL bulbs &amp; tubes – Place each bulb in a sealed plastic bag, one bulb per bag. 
