

ORDINANCE NO. O-14-019

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE AMUSEMENT TAX PROVISIONS OF
THE CITY OF WOOD DALE CITY CODE**

WHEREAS, the City of Wood Dale (hereinafter referred to as “City”) is a body politic and corporate, organized and existing pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized and empowered, under the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-42-5, to establish and repeal an amusement tax on certain amusements; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously established an amusement tax on certain amusements as set forth in Chapter 8, Article VI of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Wood Dale (“City Code”); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City has determined that the amusement tax provisions of the City Code are obsolete and have not been applicable to any existing amusements, as defined therein, for a number of years; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City to repeal the amusement tax provisions of the City Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wood Dale, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That the foregoing recitals are incorporated herein and made a part hereof as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION TWO: That Chapter 8, Article VI of the City Code is repealed in its entirety and reserved.

SECTION THREE: That the definition of “Amusement Arcade” in Chapter 4, Article 1, Section 4.102 B. of the City Code is amended to delete reference to a City amusement tax as follows:

AMUSEMENT ARCADE: Any building or structure or portion of a building or structure within which are kept for use or operation of the public four (4) or more automatic amusement devices.

SECTION FOUR: That the City Clerk of the City of Wood Dale be and is directed hereby to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form, pursuant to the statutes of the State of Illinois.

SECTION FIVE: That all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict, expressly repealed.

SECTION SIX: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in a manner provided by law.
