

ORDINANCE NO. O-14-024

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.106 THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF WOOD DALE PROVIDING FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE ILLINOIS MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT FUND

WHEREAS, the City of Wood Dale (hereinafter referred to as “City”) is a body politic and corporate, organized and existing pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wood Dale and certain of its officers and employees are authorized to participate in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund pursuant to the Illinois Pension Code, 40 ILCS 5/7-101 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.106 of the City Code presently provides for regulations concerning the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.106 was last updated in 1976 and the City Council of the City has determined that it should be updated to reflect the current state of Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wood Dale, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That the foregoing recitals are incorporated herein and made a part hereof as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION TWO: That Section 2.106 of Chapter 2, Article I of the Municipal Code of the City of Wood Dale of 1993, as amended, is restated and amended to read in its entirety:

The city does elect to participate in the Illinois municipal retirement fund, effective January 1, 1971 subject to the provisions of the Illinois Pension Code, 40 ILCS 5/7-101 *et seq.*, as amended from time to time.

SECTION THREE: That the City Clerk of the City of Wood Dale be and is directed hereby to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form, pursuant to the statutes of the State of Illinois; and

SECTION FOUR: That all other ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict, expressly repealed; and

SECTION FIVE: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in a manner provided by law.


