

ORDINANCE NO. O-14-031

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF
WOOD DALE TO ADJUST WATER METER FEES**

WHEREAS, the City of Wood Dale (hereinafter referred to as “City”) is a body politic and corporate, organized and existing pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wood Dale is authorized and empowered, under the Division 139 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-139-1 *et seq.*, and the Municipal Code of the City of Wood Dale of 1993, as amended (“Code of Ordinances”), to establish, revise, and maintain rates and charges for water and sewer service; and

WHEREAS, the Section 7.305 B. of the City Code presently provides for certain water meter fees for the installation of water meters that has not been updated since 2001; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City has determined that it is necessary and reasonable to update the water meter fees to reflect the current costs and expenses associated with the installation of water meters.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wood Dale, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That the foregoing recitals are incorporated herein and made a part hereof as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION TWO: That Section 7.305 B of Chapter 7, Article III of the Municipal Code of the City of Wood Dale of 1993, as amended, is restated and amended to read in its entirety:

B. Meter Costs: Upon their request for installation thereof, each owner shall pay a fee for a water meter determined by the diameter of the water service line to the premises:

A ten percent (10%) administrative fee shall be applied to the above referenced meter and reading device fee.

SECTION THREE: That the City Clerk of the City of Wood Dale be and is directed hereby to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form, pursuant to the statutes of the State of Illinois; and

SECTION FOUR: That all other ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict, expressly repealed; and

SECTION FIVE: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in a manner provided by law.


