

ORDINANCE NO. O-14-004

**AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. O-13-10, AMENDING
CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE III, SECTION 5.305, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE
OF THE CITY OF WOOD DALE TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF
AUTHORIZED CLASS "V" LIQUOR LICENSES**

WHEREAS, the City of Wood Dale is a body politic and corporate, organized and existing pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wood Dale is authorized and empowered, under the Illinois Municipal Code; the Liquor Control Act of 1934, 235 ILCS 5/1-1 *et seq.*; and the Municipal Code of the City of Wood Dale of 1993, as amended, to regulate the retail sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the municipal boundaries of the City and to establish the guidelines and maximum number of liquor licenses which can be issued to qualified applicants; and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2013, Ordinance No. O-13-010, amending Section 5.305 of the Municipal Code of the City of Wood Dale of 1993, as amended, to reduce the number of authorized Class "V" Liquor Licenses from one (1) to zero (0), was passed and approved by the City Council and the Mayor of the City; and

WHEREAS, it has since been determined that it is necessary to maintain one (1) authorized Class "V" Liquor License and, accordingly, that Ordinance No. O-13-010 should be rescinded,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wood Dale, DuPage County, Illinois, at a regular meeting duly assembled, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

SECTION TWO: That Ordinance No. O-13-010, amending Chapter 5, Article III, Section 5.305, of the Municipal Code of the City of Wood Dale of 1993, as amended, to reduce the number of authorized Class "V" licenses to zero (0) is hereby rescinded and that, accordingly, the number of authorized Class "V" licenses shall be one (1).

SECTION THREE: That the City Clerk of the City of Wood Dale be and is directed hereby to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form, pursuant to the statutes of the State of Illinois.

SECTION FOUR: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.


