

**ORDINANCE NO. O-14-012**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7.407 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF WOOD DALE TO REVISE THE LOCAL LIMITS ON SUBSTANCES CONTAINED IN WASTEWATER DISCHARGE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Wood Dale (hereinafter referred to as “City”) is a body politic and corporate, organized and existing pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 *et seq.*; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Wood Dale is authorized and empowered, under the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-139-8, and Section 7.407 of the Municipal Code of the City of Wood Dale of 1993, as amended (“Code of Ordinances”), to establish, revise, and maintain local limits on substances contained in wastewater discharge; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has coordinated with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (“USEPA”) in a review of the City’s current local limits on substances contained in wastewater discharge which were last fixed in 1997; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the USEPA review, the USEPA has approved revisions to the current local limits on substances contained in wastewater discharge as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City to revise the current local limits on substances contained in wastewater discharge in conformity with the limits approved by the USEPA.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Wood Dale, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That the foregoing recitals are incorporated herein and made a part hereof as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION TWO: That Section 7.407 E of Chapter 7, Article IV of the Municipal Code of the City of Wood Dale of 1993, as amended, is amended by deleting Section 7.407 E, in its entirety, and replacing with:

E. Local Limits: The following pollutant limits are established to protect against pass-through and interference. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge wastewater containing in excess of the following:

The above limits apply at the point where the wastewater is discharged to the POTW. All concentrations for metallic substances are for "total" metal unless indicated otherwise. All of the concentration limits, excluding pH, temperature, cyanide, phenols and FOG contained in this section and subsection B of this section shall apply to twenty four (24) hour composite samples. All other limits shall be met at all times (i.e., concentration limits are based on grab

samples). The director may impose mass limitations in addition to, or in place of, the concentration based limitations above.

SECTION THREE: That the City Clerk of the City of Wood Dale be and is directed hereby to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form, pursuant to the statutes of the State of Illinois.

SECTION FOUR: That all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict, expressly repealed.

SECTION FIVE: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in a manner provided by law.
